LOCAL RULES

NATIVE AREAS

All native areas on the course are considered 'Red Penalty Areas' and the edge of the penalty area is where the grass and the native area meet. Where a cart path is adjacent to the native area, the edge of the path on the native area side will act as the edge of the penalty area. Where native areas border both sides of a cart path, the path is part of the penalty area (No free relief for interference) and the edge goes across the path at the point where grass would meet the native area if the path was not there.

ANIMAL HOOF DAMAGE

In the general area or in a bunker, damage that is clearly identifiable as having been caused by animal hoofs is ground under repair and Rule 16.1 applies (Abnormal Course Conditions). Such damage on the putting green may be repaired and Rule 13.1c (2) applies.

DAMAGE BY ANIMALS

Damage in the general area caused by animals such as skunks or armadillos is considered ground under repair. Interference does not exist if the damage only interferes with the player's stance.

FIRE ANTS AND MOUNDS

Fire ants and their mounds are considered dangerous and relief is granted under Rule 16.2a and 16.2b.

OUT OF BOUNDS

Out of Bounds is defined by white stakes, barbed wire and property fences, paved roads, and homeowner yards (whether fenced or not, the line will be defined by the transition of native area to homeowner maintained grass).

PACE OF PLAY

All players and groups should maintain a 4 hour pace for 18 holes (2 hours per 9 holes). Slower groups with more than one hole open in front should allow faster groups to play through. Courtesy and respect for others creates a safe and enjoyable environment for all players.
